Join us for the Costa Mesa Historical Society's Annual Installation Dinner of Officers and Board Members to be held Friday, January 25, 2019 at the Newport Rib Company. This year's special guest speaker will be Jim Kubalik from the Richard Nixon Library and Museum. Learn about the life, legacy and the preservation of the life and times of Orange County's own Native Son U.S. President!

Richard Milhous Nixon (January 9, 1913 – April 22, 1994) was the 37th President of the United States from 1969 until his resignation in 1974 as a result of the Watergate break-in. He had previously served as the 36th Vice President of the United States from 1953 to 1961, and prior to that as both a U.S. Representative and Senator from California. A US Navy veteran, we will learn of his rise through the political ranks and then to near obscurity only to rise again. He played a prominent role during the Cold War, continued our space age legacy, steered the country through turbulent social times, ended American involvement in Vietnam and initiated diplomatic relations with mainland China. All this and more will be explored as well as the Library itself.

Our speaker is Jim Kubalik, who is a Docent and Leader of the Speakers Bureau at the Richard M. Nixon Presidential Library. He is a mentor at The Orangewood Foundation, working with OC youth as they transition from Foster Care. Jim is a CA native, attended local schools and holds a BS & MS from CSUN. He has over 35 years experience working in Risk Management in both Corp. & operations positions with Fortune 100 Companies.
