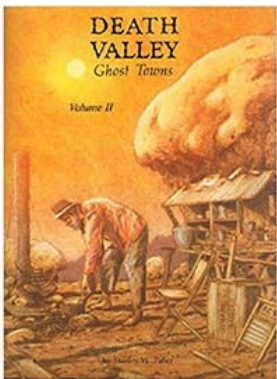
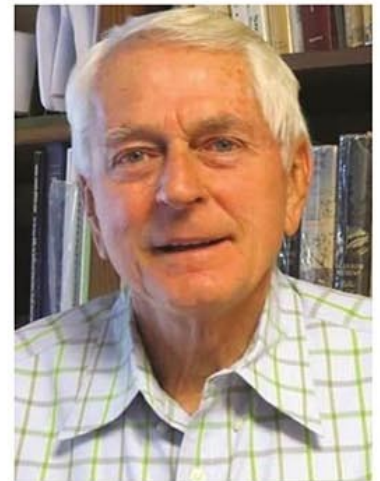


Ghost Towns of Southern California
